*\* This is an Opportunity class. Riders riding only in Opportunity classes do not need to pay USEF or USDF non-member fees, USDF HID, or drug fee. Please note that riders and horse must comply with the USEF rules including drug testing. You may enter other classes but membership/registration fees will apply.*

### 1. LEVELS

Training through Grand Prix, GAIG/USDF Qualifying, Freestyles and Stakes Classes

### 2. AWARDS

- Prize and six ribbons with High Score Champion and Reserve Champion for each day. Ties will not be broken.
- On Friday, JR/YR, AA will be pinned separately if four or more entries per nonqualifying class.
- Stakes Classes: cash prize awarded to top three places. Limited to one horse/rider combination per class. To be ridden in a large arena. No whips or readers allowed. If less than four entries, cash will be awarded by percentage.
- Candace Dixon Perpetual Trophy is awarded to the High Score Amateur Rider in Training through Second Level for each show.
- USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal is awarded to the high scoring Adult Amateur, in class 123 (Friday) & 223 (Saturday) USEF Second Test 3, that is a current USDF member who has a score of 58% or higher.

### 3. ENTRIES

- Make checks payable to King Oak Farm.
- These are two DIFFERENT shows, i.e., Dressage Days I on Friday and Dressage Days II on Saturday/Sunday. A separate entry form is needed for each show, including fees, membership fees, office fees and drug fees.
- All entries must be on 2010 OPL Entry Form and accompanied by proof a negative Coggins dated after 1/1/2010, copies of all USEF/USDF cards and a check/money order for the appropriate fees. Add non-member fees for USEF and USDF if applicable.
- Incomplete entries will be held aside, unprocessed, until all required information has been received by the show secretary.

- Post-entries/changes after closing date are assessed \$25 per entry/change
- Refunds: Before closing date, for cancellations received in writing/fax, in full less \$35 processing fee. No refunds after the closing date for any reason including Acts of God.
- Entries will be accepted on a first come basis.

#### 4. TIMES

#### 5. STABLING

Temporary stall under tents. Initial bedding (1 bag) and stall doors are provided. Bring feed/hay/bedding. Arrivals after 8 p.m. only by arrangement with stabling manager.

#### 7. DIRECTIONS

1-90 E&W: Exit 3 (Westfield); left on Rte 10 N; 7 mi. to farm on right  
 1-91 S: Exit 18 (Northampton); left off ramp on Rte 5 N; follow sign to Rte 10 S to Easthampton Ctr; 4 mi. to farm on left  
 1-91 N: Exit 15 (Ingleside/Holyoke): left at bottom of ramp (Lower Westfield Rd); right at second light (Homestead Ave); 1 mi turn left on rte 202 S, 4.3 mi turn right on Rte 10 N, 3.7 mi to farm on right.

#### 8. FOOTING

Four arenas: three large sand, one small grass. Extensive flat and rolling warm-up areas; one small sand warm-up. All other performance and warm-up areas are on grass.

#### 9. ENTERTAINMENT

Food on grounds. Competitors' party on Saturday evening. Doggy Dressage TBA

#### 10. OTHER

Farrier on grounds. Veterinarian on call, John Cowley (413) 527-4414.  
 While on the grounds, all dogs must be on a short leash that is attached to a stationary object or person.  
 Arenas close on 7 p.m. on Thursday and 1 hour after the end of competition each day.  
 Hand walking is allowed outside of the areas up to 1/2 hour before the start of competition each day.
